

- 1. Stainless Steel Plastering Trowel
- 2. Plastering Hawk (Handock)
- 3. 3mm Plastic Float

Using a Stainless Steel Trowel ensures that no rust is trasnferred during the application process




- Remove loose and flaking paint
- Clean down surface from all dirt and debris



Apply a single coat of A&Z Level Coat to prime surface and fill cracks Allow to dry for 24 hours

TOOLS



Scoop a palm size amount of A&Z Gamazine onto the edge of your plastering hawk.

> Scoop up about half of it onto your plastering trowel

CLEANING



Once your trowel is loaded, Apply product to the surface swiping from bottom to top. Aim to keep the application approximately 3-4mm thick for the best coverage.

Swiping from side to side would assist in removing any creases that may form whilst applying in the bottom to top motion

LEVEL COAT



A short while after application, run you plastic float in either a vertical or circular motion to achieved desired result.

Allow 7 days drying time
